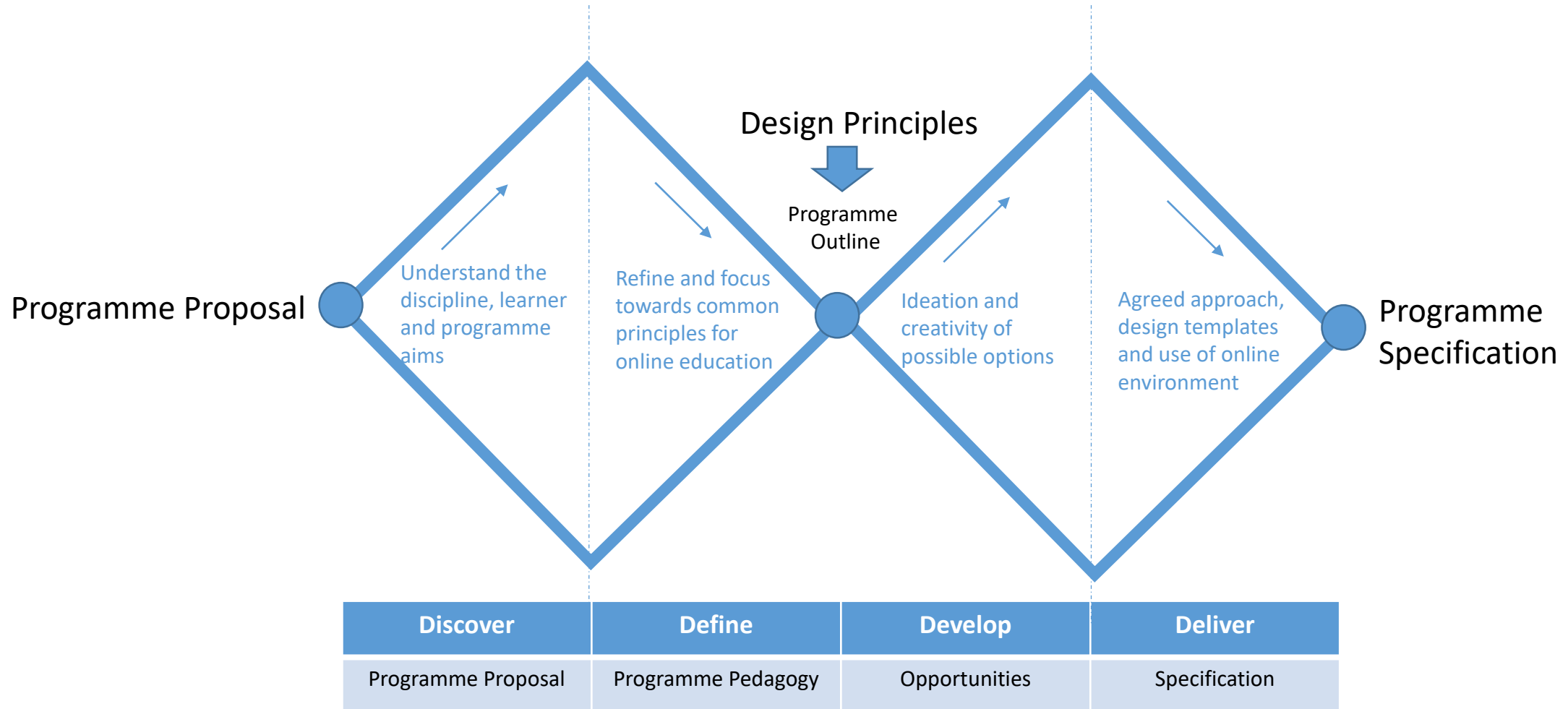


Design process model (programme)

The double diamond design model is a representation of how at the start of design processes there is a phase of identifying the design problem, before there is a phase of creating the solution. The nodes are key touch points, providing points of convergence, between which there is divergence of ideas and options. The representation below reflects a possible workshop workflow for programme-level design.
